

## **Paper/session submissions**

To submit a paper, you must be logged in to SASE's site (<https://sase.org/sign-in/>).

If you are submitting for the first time, you can create a profile here (you do not have to pay/join SASE to have a profile): [https://sase.org/register/?account\\_type=1289](https://sase.org/register/?account_type=1289).

Once you are logged in, click the "submit a paper" button on the top right. This will take you to the Confex submission system, where you will first be prompted to choose the Network/Mini-conference you wish to apply to (scroll down the page to find this).

## **Registering for the conference**

To attend the SASE conference, you must be a SASE member AND pay the conference registration fee. You can pay membership and registration at any time here: <https://sase.org/join-sase/>.

Rates are as follows (all figures are in USD).

### **For individuals from OECD countries:**

#### Membership:

Non-students: **\$130**

PhD students: **\$65**

Please note that this includes a subscription to SER but does not include conference registration fees.

#### Conference Registration:

Non-student registration (three tiers – you choose): **\$155, \$175, or \$200**

Student registration: **\$80**

Hardship fee (for those experiencing income loss due to the pandemic or other reasons): **\$50**

### **For individuals from non-OECD countries:**

**For individuals from non-OECD countries, we offer a flat fee** which includes membership, conference registration, and SER subscription.

#### Membership and registration (flat fee):

Non-students (three tiers – you choose): **\$100, \$125, or \$150**

PhD students: **\$25**
